 - o Vice-Provost and University Librarian or delegate
 - o Head, Open Scholarship Services, Queen's University Library
 - o Head, Collection Development and Assessment, Queen's University Library
 - Head, Discovery and Technology Services, Queen's University Library
 - Head, Information Services, Queen's University Library

The term of office for non-ex officio members is one year, with the possibility of extension.

Meetings and Communication

- Meetings will be held twice a year or as needed.
- All faculty members of the Faculty of Law are welcome as guests at meetings.
- The minutes will be posted on the Queen's University Library web site.
