Membership

 Bachelor of Commerce, Research-Based Programs, MBA and Professional Programs
- 1 student representing the Commerce Undergraduate Students' Society
- 3 students representing the following: MBA Programs, Research-Based Programs and Professional Programs
- Ex-officio members:
 - Head Humanities and Social Sciences Librarian (Chair)
 - o Librarians with liaison responsibilities in Business and Public Administration and other related areas
 - Dean, Smith School of Business or delegate
 - Associate Dean, Research Programs Office or delegate
 - Vice-Provost and University Librarian or delegate
 - o Head, Open Scholarship Services, Queen's University Library
 - Head, Collection Development and Assessment, Queen's University Library
 - Head, Discovery and Technology Services, Queen's University Library
 - o Head, Information Services, Queen's University Library

The term of office for non-ex-officio members is one year, with the possibility of extension.

Meetings and Communication

- Meetings will be held twice a year, or as needed.
- All faculty members of the Smith School of Business are welcome as guests at meetings.
