of tool.

Example:

“How to make the perfect bread” prompt. *Chat GPT*, 6 August version, OpenAI, 22 April. 2022,
chat.openai.com/chat.

In-Text Citation:

(Short form of inquiry)

Example:

(Make perfect bread)

APA Style

Reference:

Author of AI model used. (Year of AI model used). *Name of AI model used* (Version of AI model
used) [Type or description of AI model used].URL

Example:

OpenAI. (2023). *ChatGPT* (April 12 version) [Large language model]. <https://chat.openai.com/>

In-Text Citation:

(Author of generative AI model, Year of Version used)

Example:

(Open AI, 2022)

Sources:

Chicago Style

Reference:

Do not include it as an entry in the reference list.

Footnote

Text generated by Language Model, Month Day, Year, Publisher, URL.

Text generated by ChatGPT, Jan 1, 2023, OpenAI, <https://chat.openai.com/chat>
